Utility pole (end of fire station driveway): Mike Lavoie explained that the conduit wire is chafing (water is coming out). Mike received a call from Scott Eastman. Scott is reaching out on our behalf to the power company. Discussion – chances are it is the precincts expenditure

Administrator: NHDES Workshops: Administrator updated commissioners on the workshops, one of which was a Cybersecurity workshop. Upon completion it has been decided that we need to have Primex come and do an assessment for the precinct as it will be mandatory to have an emergency plan in place for a cybersecurity attack

Administrator: Website: Follow up on where we are at. Admin reached out to the NH municipal association for procedural advice. Once reviewed, a decision will be made on the web designer and admin will begin to draft the pages

Other Business: New rate for CC payments: Administrator stated that Quickbooks' fees for credit card payment has increased and that we have to raise what we charge our customers to 4% to cover the charges effective May 1st 2024. Motion to approve by Doug Dutile. Second by Albie Estes – all in favor
