



Article 01 To Elect the following Precinct Officers

Elect Officers
To Elect the following Precinct Officers:

- One (1) Precinct Moderator - 2 Year Term
- One (1) Precinct Commissioner - 3 Year Term
- One (1) Precinct Treasurer - 1 Year Term
- One (1) Precinct Clerk - 1 Year Term

Article 02 Appropriate Funds for General Operations

To see if the precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Sixty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$69,960.00) for general municipal operations. This article does not include appropriations contained in special or individual articles addressed separately. Recommended by the commissioners. (Majority vote required)

Article 03 Appropriate Funds for Water Dept. Operations

For the Operation of the Precinct Water Department
To see if the precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$156,250.00) for general operations of the precinct water department, with said funds to come from Water Department user fees. (Majority Vote Required)

Article 04 Appropriate to Water Dept. Capital Reserve Fund

To see if the precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Ten Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$10,360.00) to be added to the Water Department Capital Reserve Funds previously established, with said funds to come from Water Department revenues. Further, to name the Precinct commissioners as agents to expend from said fund. Recommended by the Commissioners. (Majority Vote Required)



Article 05 To Establish a Water System Maintenance CRF

To see if the precinct will vote to establish a water system maintenance Capital Reserve Fund under the provisions of RSA 35:1. To appropriate the sum of Twenty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$29,000.00) to the fund with said funds to come from unassigned fund balance. Further to name the Commissioners as agents to expend. Recommended by the Commissioners. (Majority Vote Required)

Article 06 Discontinue Funds

To see if the precinct will vote to discontinue the Precinct Corner Building Paving Fund with accumulated interest to date for withdrawal to be placed in the general fund. The commissioners recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required)

Article 07 Appropriate Funds to Precinct's Capital Reserve Fund

To see if the precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Sixty-Two Thousand and Ninety-Two Dollars (\$62,092.00) to be added to the Corner Precinct Capital Reserve Fund previously established, with said funds to come from unassigned fund balance. This represents the monies from the discontinuation of the Building Paving Fund. Recommended by the Commissioners. (Majority Vote Required)

Article 08 Establish Precinct of Haverhill Corner Maintenance Fund

To see if the precinct will vote to establish a Precinct of Haverhill Corner Maintenance Capital Reserve Fund under the provisions of RSA 35:1. To appropriate the sum of \$10,000 to be placed in this fund with said funds to come from unassigned fund balance. Further, to name the commissioners as agents to expend from said fund. Recommendations Required (Majority Vote Required)

Article 09 Appropriate to Precinct CRF



To see if the precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$10,000 to be added to the Corner Precinct CRF previously established. This sum to come from unassigned fund balance. No amount to be raised from taxation. Recommendations Required. (Majority vote required)

Article 10 Appropriate to the Library Association

To see if the precinct will vote to appropriate the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (1,500) for the purpose of a donation to the Library located in the Precinct of Haverhill Corner. This amount to come from the Precinct Taxation. (Majority Vote Required).

Article 11 To Transact on any other business

To transact on any other business that may legally come before the meeting.
